FIBER OPTIC TECHNICIAN

I. OBJECTIVE:

A. To be responsible for fiber optic cable splicing, maintenance, and installation of customer services on our fiber-to-the-home network.

II. REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS:

III. RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Fiber optic splicing (fusion and mechanical).
- B. Fiber optic troubleshooting, including OTDR and light meter readings.
- C. Perform construction-related duties, including buried and aerial drops and network extensions.
- D. Use Interpersonal skills for interaction with customers for installation requirements and issue resolution.
- E. Able to work from heights including pole, ladder, and bucket truck.
